

## **SUPPLIES:**

Glass 12" plate

Glass bowl

Fish Bowl: 1 1/2 gallon

Face template

Mop head

Yarn-various colors

Bandana

Paint

Paint brush and round dobber



## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

First, paint the inside of the plate and bowl. Put it aside to dry. Next, paint the inside of the fishbowl. Make sure the fishbowl is opening side down, then begin gluing the mop strands on the fishbowl, making sure the strands are folded in half, and glue them on the bottom ridge of the bottom of the bowl. You can embellish with yarn here and there in addition to the mop head. After the strands are a bit dry, you can unravel the mop strands and the hair appears curly. Then using a black marker, draw the lines of the face on the best side of your fishbowl. (It doesn't matter if the inside is wet.) Then paint your eyes, nose, cheeks, etc. using a paint brush and paint dobber. Next decide which leaves, flowers, etc. you want to use to embellish your hat. By this time, the plate and bowl should be dry, using a glue gun, glue the bowl onto the plate, then the plate and bowl onto the fishbowl. Dress up your hat with all the flowers, leaves, etc. Finish this off with a bandana. Enjoy!
