

- · Copy the template onto cardstock, or cardboard for easiest use
- Thin paper tends to work best. Some lightweight fabrics may be compatible.
- Use magazines like National Geographic, home gardening, seed catalogues and others for nature-based images
- Use images from damaged graphic novels or comics
- Clip a favorite word from a retired dictionary or thesaurus.
- Have patrons create their own artwork with traditional materials like colored pencils, markers, or crayons.
- · Have patrons digitally design and print their own artwork
- Print photos of friends/family on regular paper and trim to size
- Create commemorative designs specific to your event
