

Suggested Geocaching/GPS Program

Geocaching

- 1. Explain history of GPS and provide overview, making it as in-depth as you like.
- 2. Put participants into small groups. 2-3 members per group is probably best.
- 3. Give each group a GPS unit. Make sure to go over Basic Rules on the "GPS Write Up" document.
- 4. Explain how the units work. Show them the buttons and how to navigate.
- 5. Give each group a waypoint number and tell them to find that number in their GPS unit. They should then click on that number and select "go to."
- 6. Send the groups out to find their assigned cache. If you do questions, have them come back and give you the correct answer and then send them out to a different cache. (Tell them to memorize the question and answer and remind them to put the cache back where they found it.)
- 7. Finish when a couple groups have found them all or when your allotted time is up.

Suggestion: Ask the participants to pick up the caches at the end of the day, in case they didn't quite make it back to their original hiding places.
